 Child Care Services Association Core Services - Ensure that consumer education, referral and public awareness materials/services are available and offered in order to meet the North Carolina Child Care Resource & Referral consumer and education standards. 2,368 preschool referrals were made, surpassing the original goal of 1,950 for an overall rate of 121%. Ensure that technical assistance is provided in the two most commonly used languages in each community. The technical assistance goal of 174 classrooms was surpassed and a total of 675 classrooms received TA. Ensure that appropriate professional development and training is available for child care providers. 2,372 child care professionals attended trainings. Ensure that appropriate and accurate data is collected and quality assurance measures are in place. Monitoring visits were made to county regional partners and quarterly reports were compiled.

 Quality, Education, Support, and Training (QUEST) - Works with child care facilities promoting quality care through consultations, classroom improvement plans, professional development plans, and center-based and/or individual-based grant awards. 66 child care professionals in 11 centers/homes received assistance and training to increase the quality of child care; 131 child care professionals in 23 centers/homes received assistance and training to maintain the quality of child care; 204 teachers developed an education plan; 12 centers/homes submitted an application for a higher star-rated license; 44 new/potential early childhood professionals received start-up consultations; 14 home providers received assistance for quality in-home child care; 57 early childhood professionals participated in the "positive guidance" initiative to improve teacher-child interactions in the classroom environment; 14 directors received assistance for quality in child care administration; 49 early childhood professionals received technical assistance for quality in infant/toddler child care; 20 child care centers that completed re-assessment maintained or improved their star rating of 3-star or higher; 35 classrooms showed an increase in quality care based on the Infant-Toddler Environment Rating Scale.

 Child Links - The only program in the community that provides free child care referrals to parents, as well as a free resource library of developmentally appropriate toys for young children. It is also the only program for child care providers that comprehensively offers training, early childhood information, curriculum resources, and use of computers and materials for lesson planning. ChildLinks serves as the lead agency for the 7-county child care resource and referral region. 555 Martin and Pitt County families received child care referrals; 976 early childhood professionals from 252 facilities attended 91 trainings; 407 early childhood professionals and 105 parents have accessed resource centers 3,428 times to use early childhood books, videos, games, toys, die cuts, computer labs, lamination, and other equipment; 194 licensed child care centers and homes in both Martin and Pitt Counties were listed with ChildLinks NACCRAware database for child care referrals; 78 centers and homes received short-term technical assistance.
